

Circle Surface Sun From Somewhere in the Mediterranean

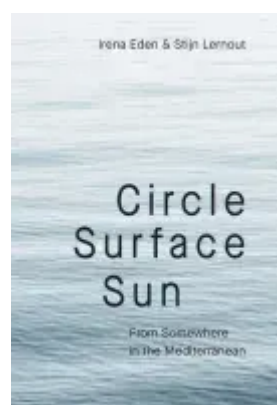
