

Big Critical Energy

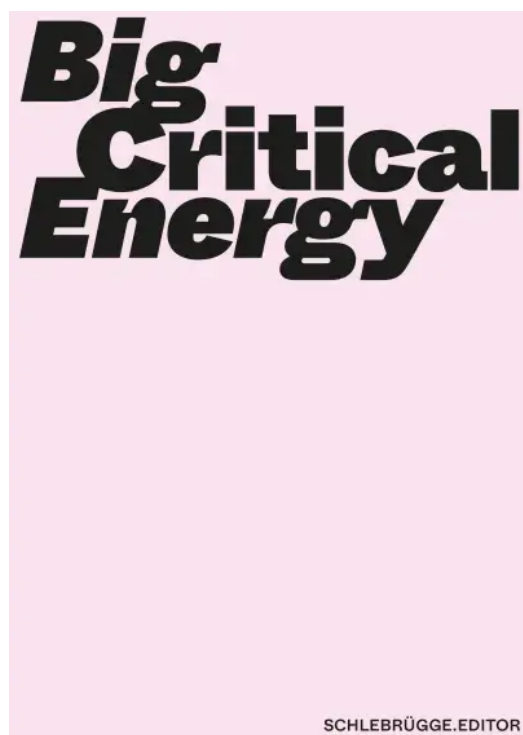
